About

This simple menu allows the status of an event to be displayed in a menu with a graphic. The status can be changed by one of 4 different ways. WAP access to a script, mobile pda browser to a script (these prompt for a password), by directly typing in a url which you can book mark or by a userclass defined button in the menu.

Installation

The plugin is copied to your plugins' directory and installed in the usual way. Copy launch.php to the root of your server. Go to the configuration screen to set the options.

- Set a password to access the launch script remotely.
- Define a userclass who can see the "step status" button
- Set the name that you wish to appear at the top row above the graphic.
- If you need to force wap for remote access then check the box. Normally the script will pick up if it is a wap browser rather than HTML
- There are ordinarily three states that can be cycled through. To force only two then check this box.
- Select the icons you want for the three states.

Operation

From a mobile phone browse to www.yourdomain.com/launch.php and enter the password to change the status.

Or to launch, browse to www.yourdomain.com/launch.php?passcode=12345&status=launch

Or to go on station, browse to www.yourdomain.com/launch.php?passcode=12345&status=station

Or to go to status 3, browse to www.yourdomain.com/launch.php?passcode=12345&status=status3

Change the passcode to the one you have set in the main configuration.

From the menu, click on the button if you are in the correct user class.
